# Your Supervisory Team



## Director of Studies (DoS)

The primary role is to provide expert guidance in the subject area and to coordinate the supervisory support provided for their postgraduate researcher.

The role is wide ranging including subject-specific support, pastoral support, administration, and regulatory advice

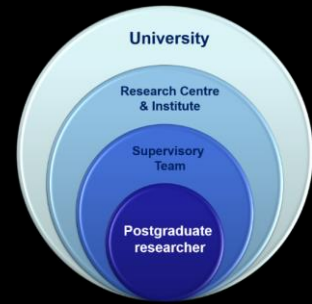
## Co-supervisor

The Ethics Lead provides advice on ethical best practice or issues.

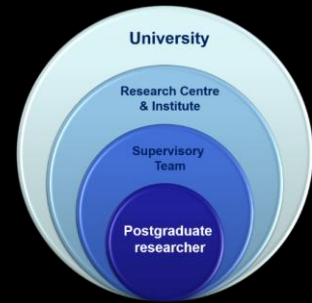

**1) User ID - your User ID is the part of your email address before the '@'**

For example, if your Coventry University student email address is **custudent@uni.coventry.ac.uk** then your UserID is **custudent**

For Solar, CU Moodle use your UserID

**2) Coventry University ID - UserID@coventry.ac.uk (NOT your student email)**

For Library Locate, Student Portal and ReCap event bookings.

**3) Coventry University student email address - UserID@uni.coventry.ac.uk**

For Microsoft Office365 Services (Microsoft Teams or Outlook Email) use your CU student email address.
